***Project Title/Description:**

Emergency Services Network (ESN)

***Purpose:**

Interfaith Community Services, a subrecipient, assists households with emergency utility and rental/mortgage financial assistance through case management services. On November 2, 2021 the Pima County Board of Supervisors approved Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds passed through Arizona Department of Economic Security. LIHEAP allows for case management, energy advocacy, energy burden education and utility assistance to prevent utility disconnection and reconnections. This amendment will provide ARPA funding of \$51,465 for LIHEAP case management.

***Procurement Method:**

Pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code 11.12.020, Competitive sealed proposals, RFP No. CAA-ESN-2018-06 was conducted with delegated authority.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

Interfaith Community Services will provide emergency financial assistance to 1,440 eligible low-income households.

***Public Benefit:**

The benefit of the program is that it will help in alleviating poverty, prevent homelessness, prevent utility shutoffs while promoting self-sufficiency to Pima County residents.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

Monthly case management and service reports.

***Retroactive:**

Yes, due to budgets for subrecipients could not be written until the County received the executed funding agreement from the State which was December 9, 2021. The negative impact of not approving this amendment is low-income families might not receive emergency utility assistance.

GRANT FUNDED AGREEMENT – AMENDMENT SEVEN

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.

- 1.1 **Background.** On June 19, 2018, Pima County (“County”) and Interfaith Community Services (“Subrecipient”), entered into the above referenced contract to provide supportive services and emergency assistance to the eligible low-income families in Pima County. Due to processing delays related to the County budget for this program and resulting delayed County approval, this amendment must be retroactive to July 2021.
- 1.2 **Purpose.** County through its Community Action Agency, as Grantee, is the recipient of State and Federal Grants for operating the local Emergency Services Network (“ESN”) to provide emergency financial assistance for qualified households to prevent homelessness or utility disconnection. On November 2, 2021 the Pima County Board of Supervisors approved Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds passed through Arizona Department of Economic Security. This amendment is to provide additional LIHEAP funds. County has reviewed Subrecipient’s performance of services and finds it satisfactory.

2. SCOPE OF SERVICES. The Commencement Date for this Amendment No. 7 is July 1, 2021.

3. COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT.

3.1. Paragraph 3.1 is amended to increase “the Maximum Allocated Amount” from \$1,216,130.25 to \$1,267,595.25. In addition, the table in Paragraph 3.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

3.2 ARP allows grantees to obligate any portion of these supplemental funds in FFY2021 or FFY2022, contingent on their own rules for obligating their own funds (45 CFR 96.30(a)). Thus, grantees and subgrantees must exclude the amount of these supplemental funds from the total amount of the base funding when determining the total amount of LIHEAP resources available to carryover to FFY2021. That is because at least 90% of the regular block grant FY 2021 funding must still be obligated by September 30, 2021 (this fiscal year).

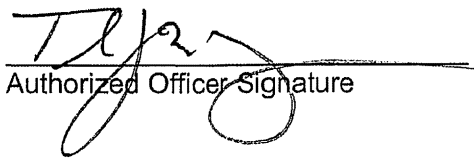
