State Grants-In-Aid (SGIA) 2025 for Pima County						

*Purpose:

State Grants-in-Aid funding for Pima County Public Library (PCPL) will support community engagement, literacy promotion, and professional development aligned with our evolving service model. This year, PCPL will focus on expanding outreach, enhancing literary arts programming, and increasing community participation through key events such as the Tucson Festival of Books (TFOB) and other cultural initiatives.

*Procurement Method:

The grant award did not require the Pima County Attorney's Office review or signature.

*Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:

The Library will strengthen community outreach, foster collaboration with local and regional authors, and enhance its literary arts programming. In 2025, PCPL aims to increase participation at the Tucson Festival of Books (TFOB) and similar events, ensuring diverse voices are represented. Through targeted support for staff development and improved event coordination, the Library will create more meaningful and inclusive engagement with the community.

*Public Benefit:

Pima County residents will benefit from enhanced educational, cultural, and economic opportunities through the library's active engagement in community events and outreach. By expanding access to diverse literary programming and professional development, PCPL will continue to meet the evolving needs of the community, fostering inclusivity and cultural enrichment.

*Metrics Available to Measure Performance:

PCPL will use a combination of community engagement indicators, attendance tracking, and staff feedback to measure performance. This will include participation rates at the Tucson Festival of Books (TFOB) and other events, as well as post-event evaluations to assess the effectiveness of outreach and programming.

*Retroactive:

Yes. The Arizona State Library issues award notifications in August based on the previous year's reporting, with a performance period beginning on July 1, 2024. PCPL submits the application after receiving the award notice and after application approval is granted. If this award is not approved, Pima County residents will face reduced access to essential resources, and community engagement with PCPL will be diminished.

Dear, Amber,

The Pima County Public Library has been designated to receive \$25000 to support library services in the 2025 fiscal year (7-1-24 through 6-30-25). The State Legislature appropriated this funding in general State Grants-in-Aid for this fiscal year. Attached is the official award notification. You'll find more information about the program at https://azlibrary.gov/libdev/funding/sgia.

To receive these funds, complete the SGIA 2024 final report (as instructed in an email dated July 10, 2024) and submit <u>an online SGIA 2025 application</u> through our grants management system. The application is due by <u>December 31, 2024</u>.

Changes in Funding Amount for SGIA 2025: Due to the way in which SGIA funding is calculated, the amount awarded to municipal libraries with populations of 100,000 or more has changed for fiscal year 2025. Specifically, the addition of the Surprise Public Library System to the list of qualified recipients means that the total award to municipalities, which is calculated as a percentage of the total allotment based on their service population, is further divided, leading to a slight decrease of about 3-5% as compared to awards made with SGIA 2024.
