Justification for Marana Unified School District (TUSD), Immunization Program

Introduction

PCHD is mandated, pursuant to A.R.S. §36-673 to provide students with immunizations required for school attendance. To this end we have worked with the Marana Unified School District for many years to support their immunization reporting, ensure enrolled children are up-to-date with vaccinations, and facilitate compliance with this statute.

This amendment extends this collaboration into the next school year. MUSD approved the agreement on December 4, 2014, MUSD's Legal Counsel signed on December 16, 2014, and the County recently received the document for final approval on January 13, 2015. We therefore seek retroactive approval for this agreement to December 5, 2014.

Discussion

MUSD depends on their collaboration with the Health Department to provide training and technical assistance to support their School Nurses and other personnel in a variety of activities and tasks related to childhood immunization compliance and management among MUSD student. This effort is particularly important for low-income families and those living in areas with poor access to health care services. The result is generally of all these efforts are relatively high vaccine compliance rates (98%) for this school district during the last contract year.

Financial Impact

There are no un-budgeted costs to the County General Fund associated with this agreement. The IGA allows PCHD to use ADHS/CDC contract resources to provide the technical support and assistance described above to Marana Unified School District.

Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the IGA.
