The Information Technology Department (ITD) requests that the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) for Pima County ITD Subscriber Services Agreement with United States Marshals Service be submitted to the Pima County Board of Supervisors for approval at their January 6, 2015 meeting. The IGA outlines the obligations of the parties relevant to the scope of this Agreement, including costs. The IGA is made and entered into by the parties pursuant to A.R.S. §§11-951 through 11-954, A.R.S. §15-1625(B)(2), and 41-2631 through 41-2634.

United States Marshals Service is a participant in the Pima County Wireless Integrated Network (PCWIN), and already owns radios that are compatible for this purpose. Pima County ITD Wireless Division and City of Tucson General Services Division are the only two service providers authorized by the PCWIN Board of Directors for subscriber repair and maintenance. United States Marshals Service has chosen Pima County ITD Wireless Division to provide this service. Therefore, since Pima County ITD Wireless Services Division has sufficient facilities, resources, and expertise to maintain and service PCWIN communication equipment, United States Marshals Service has agreed to pay Pima County for use and repair of the equipment as specified in Exhibits A-B.

This IGA is for a one-year term effective upon endorsement by the Pima County Board of Supervisors, with option to renew upon mutual consent of the parties.
