PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, serious mental illness such as major depression, bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, obsessive-compulsive disorder, severe anxiety disorders, borderline personality disorder, and post-traumatic stress disorders affect one in every five families; and

WHEREAS, serious mental illness is a highly treatable medical illness of the brain posing the same concern as cancer, heart disease, diabetes and other illnesses; and

WHEREAS, scientific research is working vigorously toward breakthroughs in the understanding of mental illness, resulting in more effective treatments that allow people to reclaim full and productive lives; and

WHEREAS, serious misunderstandings still exist about mental illness, and social culture often wrongly imposes a stigma on mental illness; and

WHEREAS, every citizen and community can make a difference in helping to improve the lives of individuals and families affected by mental illness;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims October 6, 2013, through October 12, 2013, to be:

"MENTAL ILLNESS AWARENESS WEEK"

in Pima County to increase public awareness of mental illness and to promote its treatment and recovery.
