Reconfiguration Implementation Phase Agreement, 800 MHz Rebanding Project
Contract #CT-IT-150000000000000000000006

The Information Technology Department requests to enter into a Direct Select contract with Motorola Solutions, Inc. to provide professional services to complete the mandatory, 800 MHz Rebanding Project. This agreement succeeds the Reconfiguration Planning Phase Agreement with Motorola that was executed in January 2014 (#CT-IT-1400000000000000241).

As the deadline approaches to complete the Project, the IT Department finds sufficient need for Motorola Solution's specialized expertise in order to comply with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") Report and Order, FCC 04-168, in WT Docket 02-55 as modified in the Supplemental Order, FCC 04-294 (together, "the Report and Order"). As the contractor for the federally mandated Project, Sprint/Nextel has subcontracted with Motorola to provide such services in accordance with the Report and Order, and all costs associated with this project are borne by Sprint/Nextel as stipulated under section 5.1.2. of this Motorola Agreement. Pima County has already negotiated a separate contract with Sprint/Nextel to cover these costs; the Frequency Reconfiguration Agreement with Nextel West Corporation was approved by the Pima County Board of Supervisors on December 9, 2014 (CTN-IT-1500000000000000053).

The Motorola Reconfiguration Implementation Phase Agreement is effective upon endorsement by the Pima County Board of Directors through July 15, 2018, with option to renew upon mutual consent of the parties.
