**Agenda Item #16 Monthly Financial Update**

Pima County 2023/2024 budget was passed and approved within the past few months. Reading the 10/5/23 Monthly Financial Update from Administrator Leshar is surprising. Six departments are listed as over budget on June 2024. Again, the Sheriff's Department shows shortage of almost \$8MIL. Why when in June and July the Board of Supervisors heard an in-depth review of the Sheriff's explanation for a shortage? Clearly all individuals responsible for department budgets and projections need extensive training in order to provide accurate budget information. Training also may be needed in order to evaluate their personnel productivity in order to understand where to cut unnecessary expenses.
