This master agreement is for an initial term of one (1) year in the annual award amount of \$450,000.00 (including sales tax) and includes four (4) one-year renewal options.

- Agenda Item #28: <u>Award</u>: <u>Multiple Supplier Contracts</u>, to provide for janitorial services. These contracts are for an initial term of one (1) year in the total annual award amount of \$4,000,000.00 (including sales tax) and include four (4) one-year renewal options.
