AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING TRAFFIC AT THE INTERSECTION OF CLUB DRIVE AND SHANNON ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-643 as amended, to place and maintain traffic control devices, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is necessary for the protection and convenience of the traveling public of Pima County, Arizona, to install and maintain traffic control signals at the intersection of Club Drive and Shannon Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. Traffic control signals be erected and maintained at the intersection of Club Drive and Shannon Road.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that the traffic signals are permanently placed in operation.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
