**Title:** 2017 Annual Vehicle Exemptions

**Introduction/Background:**

In accordance with A.R.S. 38-538, Board of Supervisors approval is required to issue vehicle marking exemptions and undercover plates for certain County vehicles.

**Discussion:**

Various County Departments are requesting that certain vehicles be exempt from vehicle markings and issued undercover plates. These requests require the Board of Supervisors approval in order for the State of Arizona, Motor Vehicle Division, to grant exemption in accordance with A.R.S. 38-538.03. Those vehicles are used to conduct rehabilitation or social service programs, felony investigations or activities of a confidential nature. A listing of the vehicles is on file with the Fleet Services Department.

**Conclusion:**

Board of Supervisors approval is required to grant vehicle marking exemptions, per A.R.S. 38-538.03.

**Recommendation:**

It is recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the annual vehicle exemptions in accordance with A.R.S. 38-538.03. If approved, certain County vehicles will continue to receive undercover plates and will be exempt from vehicle markings. If denied, all undercover plates on these vehicles will expire and will then be required to have vehicle markings and issued government plates.
