RESOLUTION NO. 2014-

RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL WORKFORCE INVESTMENT PLAN FOR FIVE YEARS TO OPERATE THE PIMA COUNTY ONE-STOP SYSTEM WHICH PROVIDES ASSISTANCE TO COUNTY RESIDENTS IN NEED OF WORKFORCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, Pima County has been designated by the State of Arizona as a Local Workforce Investment Area under the federal Workforce Investment Act of 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Supervisors has designated the Community Services Employment and Training Department (CSET) as the One Stop Career Center Operator for the Workforce Investment Act; and

WHEREAS, CSET will provide support to the Workforce Investment Board; and

WHEREAS, the One Stop Career Center works with over 700 local companies and 15,000 jobs seekers; and

WHEREAS; the Pima County Board of Supervisors has appointed members of the Workforce Investment Board to make recommendations to the Board of Supervisors regarding Workforce Investment Act programs; and

WHEREAS; Pima County is required to submit a five year plan to the State of Arizona in order to receive federal Workforce Investment Act funds to operate the One Stop Career Center; and

WHEREAS, at its December 13, 2013 meeting, the Pima County Workforce Investment Board approved and recommended that the Pima County Board of Supervisors adopt the five year plan and submit it to the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the five year plan supports and compliments the Pima County Economic Development Plan that was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on November 12, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the five year plan articulates an industry strategy supportive of the Aerospace and Defense, Emerging Technology, Health and Bioscience, Logistics, Renewable Resources and Infrastructure Sectors; and

WHEREAS, these six sectors are targeted by both the Pima County Economic Development Plan and the Tucson Regional Economic Opportunities, Inc. for development and growth in Pima County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Pima County Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Ratifies the Local Workforce Investment Five-Year Plan;
- 2. Authorizes the Pima County One Stop Career Center, through CSET, and the Pima County Workforce Investment Board to submit such plan to the State of Arizona; and
