Title: Pima County Workforce Investment Board

## Introduction/Background:

The Pima County Workforce Investment Board (WIB) is the Board of Supervisors local area workforce development board under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WiOA) for the local area. The WIB reviews and oversees workforce policy. funding, develops a regional workforce plan, reviews training provider performance and aids in the development of a workforce talent pipeline in Pima County.

#### Discussion:

The following individuals seek reappointment to serve on the WIB with the term expiration of September 30, 2025: (1) Peter Loya, Campus Research Corporation, Business (2) Ramon Serrato, Serrato Corporation, Business (3) Karen King, Joint Training and Electrical Apprenticeship Program, Workforce, Labor Organization Representative nominated by local labor federation (4) Frank Grijalva, International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local, Workforce, Labor Organization and Joint Labor Management (5) Natalya Brown, The Beacon Group, Workforce Community Based Organization (6) Dr. David Dore, Pima Community College, Education and Training, Higher Education (7) Aric Meares, Spectrum Plastics, Business

### Conclusion:

Appointment by the Board will ensure that our local area retains compliance of WIOA local board composition. By appointing (3) the WIB retains its mandated composition and workforce activities under the WIOA continue in Pima County. WIB composition will be a total of 37, with 19 business (51%), 9 workforce (24%). It is the intent of the WIB and Community & Workforce Development (CWD) to continue the recruitment of business representatives for Board consideration and to bring pending reappointments forward at a later date. 22mold2RCLK

### Recommendation:

Staff recommend the revisions be approved as listed in the discussion in order to remain compliant with federal statute.

## Fiscal Impact:

If approved, the local area remains compliant, workforce development activities and no fiscal impact occurs. If not approved, the state will be notified that the local area workforce board does not meet composition compliance and will have 120 days to correct the issue. If issue is not corrected within 120 days, the state may start the process to decertify the local area as a workforce development area under the WIOA.
