***Project Title/Description:**

First Amendment to the Affirm Sexual and Reproductive Health Sexually Transmitted Infection Screening Contract

***Purpose:**

This grant contract provides funding for chlamydia screening services for sexually active female clients 24 years of age and younger and syphilis screening services to sexually active male and female clients 34 years of age and younger. The purpose of this screening grant is to decrease chlamydia and syphilis rates in Pima County through increased access to testing and education services.

Due to increased performance by PCHD, Affirm is increasing the funding from \$26,000 to \$47,000 with this Amendment #1.

***Procurement Method:**

This revenue contract is a non-Procurement contract and not subject to Procurement rules.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

The goals of the program include:

- Increase access to chlamydia screening, primarily for uninsured, sexually active women 24 years of age and younger.
- Increase access to syphilis screening services for sexually active male and female clients 34 years of age and younger.
- Decrease syphilis and chlamydia rates among sexually active men and women.
- Decrease negative outcomes of chlamydia and syphilis related to reproductive health and congenital defects.
- Decrease syphilis rates among men who have sex with men, who are historically disproportionately impacted by Sexually Transmitted Diseases (STDs).

***Public Benefit:**

When left untreated, chlamydia and syphilis can lead to a myriad of health complications, including Pelvic Inflammatory Disease (PID), premature delivery, ectopic pregnancy, miscarriage, stillbirth and infant death. STD treatment can have a huge economic impact. For example, treatment for PID alone costs about \$3,200 per case. Access to testing can help, not only to learn one's status, but also to reduce disease transmission and the health-related implications associated with untreated infections.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

The following metrics will be looked at:

- Appropriate screening is done for sexually transmitted diseases;
- Follow up of positive screenings is done in accordance with the latest clinical guidelines;
- Chlamydia and syphilis screening numbers are reported on a monthly basis;
- Hours and locations ensure easy access by the target population; and
- Outreach and education is conducted on a regular basis.

***Retroactive:**

Yes. This contract has an effective date of Jan. 1, 2023. Unfortunately, it was not received from Affirm until August 3, 2023. If the amendment is not approved, Pima County will not have access to these additional funds to address chlamydia and syphilis.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AFFIRM SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH
SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTION SCREENING CONTRACT**

This FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AFFIRM SEXUAL AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH SEXUALLY TRANSMITTED INFECTION SCREENING CONTRACT dated as set forth in the signature block below (this “***Amendment***”), amends that certain Affirm Sexual and Reproductive Health Sexually Transmitted Infection Screening Contract (the “***Contract***”) dated **August 3, 2023**, and entered into between the Arizona Family Health Partnership dba Affirm Sexual and Reproductive Health, an Arizona not-for-profit corporation (“***Affirm***”), and **Pima County Health Department** (the “***Contractor***”). Affirm or the Contractor may be referred to individually as the “***Party***” or collectively the “***Parties***”.

Any capitalized terms not defined in this Amendment have the same meaning attributed to them in the Contract.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, Affirm has funding that would allow it to expand the terms of the Contract.

AGREEMENT

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants herein and intending to be legally bound thereby, Affirm and the Contractor agree as follows:

1. **Amendment to Section 2.2 Payment and Reporting.** Section 2.2 of the Contract is amended to read as follows:

The total maximum consideration payable to the Contractor pursuant to Article II is **\$47,000**. All payments payable pursuant to this Contract are contingent on the following conditions, and will be made within 30 days of delivery of the last report due under this Section:

2. **Execution.** This Amendment will not be effective until it has been approved as required by the governing bodies of the Parties and signed by the persons having executory powers for the Parties. This Amendment may be executed in two or more identical counterparts, by manual or electronic signature.




