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AMENDMENT TWO

1. Background and Purpose.

- 1.1. Background. On May 18, 2021, Pima County ("County") and Sunnyside Unified School District ("District"), entered into the above-referenced Intergovernmental Agreement ("Agreement") to provide a high quality preschool classes at a District site without cost to low-income families. County determined that funding preschool expansion for low-income families that wish to enroll their preschool-age children in high quality preschools will improve the economic health and welfare of those children, their parents, employers, and taxpayers.
- **1.2. Purpose.** The Parties want to decrease the funding and change family eligibility of household income from 200% Federal Poverty Limit to 300% Federal Poverty Limit, in addition to reducing the number of students within eligible classrooms.

2. Party Responsibilities.

- 2.1. Exhibit A Section 1, Family Eligibility, is replaced in its entirely with the following:
 - 1. Family Eligibility: To be eligible for the Program, families must have children ages three to five not eligible for Kindergarten, with a household income at or below 300% of the Federal Poverty Level.

3. Financing.

- **3.1.** The maximum allocated amount in Section 7.1 is decreased by \$8,165.60 County's total payments to District under this Agreement will not exceed \$920,746.40.
- **3.2.** Section 7.2.2 in the first Amendment is modified to remove school year 2023-2024 from the paragraph.

- 3.3. Section 7.2 of the first Amendment is amended to add the following:
 - 3.3.1. 7.2.4. For school year 2023-2024: Up to \$155,545.20 per 18-child class per 10-month program (3-year-old class or mixed 3-5-year-olds not eligible for Kindergarten). These rates are based on the following per child amounts: \$8,641.40 per child per 10-month program. Because the total cost per child is estimated at \$10,391.40, the District will make an in-kind contribution of \$1,750 per child in addition to the \$8,641.40 per child paid by the City. The District's in-kind contributions include classroom space, utility costs, custodian services, security, and administrative overhead (Human Resources, Information Technology, payroll processing, etc.), that are valued at approximately \$1,750 per 10-month program per child.
- **4.** This Amendment may be executed in any number of counterparts, each counterpart is considered an original, and together the counterparts constitute one and the same instrument.

All other provisions of the Agreement not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
