ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION and/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - ____, An ordinance of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, establishing Prima Facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on Campbell Avenue in Pima County, Arizona. Staff recommends **APPROVAL**. (District 1)

The reason for this ordinance is to reduce the speed limit on Campbell Avenue from 655 feet north of the west leg of Ina Road to 250 feet south of the west leg of Ina Road from 35 mph to 25 mph.

Based on a 2014 traffic study, it is recommended that the speed limit on Campbell Avenue from 655 feet north of the west leg of Ina Road to 250 feet south of the west leg of Ina Road be reduced from 35 mph to 25 mph. This reduction in speed limit will provide a travel speed that will enhance safety for drivers approaching a dead end traffic circle. A recent fatality at the end of Campbell Avenue prompted the Cobblestone HOA to request a review of the dead end traffic circle. The Cobblestone HOA has no objection to the reduction of the posted speed limit from 35 mph to 25 mph as drivers approach the dead end traffic circle. The speed limits on the remaining segments of Campbell Avenue shall remain the same.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING PRIMA FACIE REASONABLE SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON CAMPBELL AVENUE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627, 28-701 and 28-703, as amended, to fix prima facie reasonable speed limits on through highways, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined the prima facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on portions of Campbell Avenue,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit for motor vehicles on Campbell Avenue shall be established as follows:

<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
a) 35 mph	175 feet north of River Road	250 feet south of the west leg of Ina Road

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2002-017 is repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highways herein listed giving notice of the prima facie reasonable speed limits.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.




