CONTRACT AMENDMENT

The parties agree to amend the above-referenced contract as follows:

1. Background and Purpose.

1.1. Background. On 7-1-2016, County and Contractor entered into an agreement to promote and enhance tourism, business travel, film production & youth, amateur, semi-professional, & professional sports development and marketing.

1.2. Purpose. Due to better than expected increase of hotel/motel taxes this fiscal year, County wishes to pass increase to Contractor.

2. Term. The Contract terminates on June 30, 2021.

3. Maximum Payment Amount. The maximum amount the County will spend under this Contract, as set forth in Section 1.2, is increased by \$200,000.00. County's total payments to Contractor under this contract, including any sales taxes, will not exceed \$2,200,000.00.

4. Israel Boycott Certification. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Contract has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.

All other provisions of the Contract not specifically changed by this Amendment remain in effect and are binding upon the parties.
