

### Regional Collaboration Highlights

#### Pathways to Removing Obstacles to Housing (PRO Housing) Grant \$7M

- \$1M over life of award for transportation impact fee subsidy
- \$2M in gap funding for affordable housing development in high opportunity neighborhoods

#### <u>Preservation and Reinvestment Initiatives for Community Enhancement (PRICE) Grant</u> \$11.5M

- Gap financing and technical support for mobile home residents in City
- Rehab / replacement for manufactured and mobile homes in County and City
- Eviction prevention and legal assistance for County residents at-risk of displacement from leased manufacture housing in mobile home lots.
