Title: River Road No Stopping, Standing or Parking Ordinance

Introduction/Background:

A citizen request was received related to vehicles parking on the north unpaved shoulder of River Road east of Camino Boscaje Escondido. Camino Boscaje Escondido is a private road that accesses the gated community of Catalina Foothills Estates. It was reported that parked vehicles, such as landscaping and delivery vehicles, consistently park at this location and limit intersection sight distance. Based on discussions with the gate guard and HOA management company, vehicles temporarily park on the unpaved shoulder of River Road for a short duration until the gate opens at 7:00 a.m. The HOA management company has issued notices to the residents to request that any maintenance or delivery vehicles accessing their homes arrive no earlier than 7:00 a.m. It was stated that even if the gate is opened earlier, the vehicles would still arrive early.

Discussion:

Pima County Department of Transportation staff observed two vehicles parked on the north unpaved shoulder of River Road east of Camino Boscaje Escondido prior to 7:00 a.m on a weekday. The vehicles that were observed were not parked in a manner that limited intersection sight distance. However, depending on how vehicles park on the unpaved shoulder, they may limit intersection sight distance. The sight distance issue related to parked vehicles has been reported as a constant issue by a citizen, the HOA management company and the gate guard.

Conclusion:

A No Stopping, Standing or Parking ordinance for the Pima County portions of River Road is recommended in its entirety. A blanket ordinance in this manner allows staff the flexibility of posting No Stopping, Standing or Parking signs on River Road where recommended after a study review. The ordinance comes in to effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the roadway. This improves the efficiency and response time in posting No Stopping, Standing or Parking signs, in comparison to creating an ordinance for each spot location on River Road for approval by the Board of Supervisors. This will also consolidate the existing No Parking ordinances for River Road into a single ordinance.

Recommendation:

A No Stopping, Standing or Parking ordinance is recommended for the following Pima County portions of River Road: Shannon Road to 842 feet west of Oracle Road, 90 feet east of Oracle Road to Stone Loop, 568 feet west of Hillcrest Drive to 724 feet east of Hillcrest Drive, 1872 feet west of Via Entrada to 70 feet east of Camino Luz, 75 feet east of Campbell Avenue to 20 feet east of Camino Escuela, 568 feet east of Camino Escuela to 53 feet east of Hacienda Del Sol Road, 220 feet west of County Club Road to Alvernon Way, Alvernon Way to 80 feet east of Craycroft Road, 20 feet west of Calle Agua Verde to Sabino Canyon Road. As a result, the following No Parking ordinances are recommended to be repealed, as they are consolidated into the proposed ordinance: 1977-106 (2), 1985-176 (1), 1987-026 (1), 1991-017 (1), 1993-029 (1), 1993-142 (1a, 1b, and 1c), 2004-083 (1), 2009-016 (a,b, and c).

ORDINANCE 2018 - _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA, RELATING TO TRAFFIC AND HIGHWAYS; REGULATING PARKING ON RIVER ROAD IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA FINDS THAT:

1. The Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona has authority under A.R.S. § 28-627 and 28-873 to regulate the stopping, standing and parking of vehicles.
2. The Board of Supervisors has determined that it is in the interest of public safety that vehicles should not stop, stand or park on portions of River Road in Pima County, Arizona.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA:

SECTION 1. Parking on both sides of River Road within Pima County jurisdiction shall be regulated as No Stopping, Standing, or Parking for the following segments:

<u>Shannon Road</u>	<u>842 feet west of Oracle Road</u>
<u>90 feet east of Oracle Road</u>	<u>Stone Loop</u>
<u>568 feet west of Hillcrest Drive</u>	<u>724 feet east of Hillcrest Drive</u>
<u>1,872 feet west of Via Entrada</u>	<u>70 feet east of Camino Luz</u>
<u>75 feet east of Campbell Avenue</u>	<u>20 feet east of Camino Escuela</u>
<u>568 feet east of Camino Escuela</u>	<u>53 feet east of Hacienda Del Sol Road</u>
<u>220 feet west of Country Club Road</u>	<u>Alvernon Way</u>
<u>Alvernon Way</u>	<u>80 feet east of Craycroft Road</u>
<u>260 feet west of Calle Agua Verde</u>	<u>Sabino Canyon Road</u>

SECTION 2. Ordinances 1977-106 (2), 1985-176 (1), 1987-026 (1), 1991-017 (1), 1993-029 (1), 1993-142 (1a, 1b & 1c), 2004-083 (1), 2009-016 (a, b & c) are repealed, and other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take into effect when and to the extent that no stopping, standing or parking signs are posted on the highway herein giving notice of the parking restriction.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
