RE **Agenda item 42**, National Association of County and City Health Officials NACCHO, Amendment No. 1, to provide for the Wastewater Surveillance for SARS-CoV-2 Mentorship Program, extend grant term to 7/31/24... GTAM 24-27.

Greetings,

Instead of testing our water for high levels of arsenic, aluminum, barium, chloroform, chromium, fluoride, glyphosate, lead, (lithium-ion phosphate courtesy of the American Battery Factory coming soon), mercury, microplastics, nitrites, pesticides, pharmaceutical drugs, PCBs, petroleum products, trihalomethanes, and VOCs. Here, the Pima County Board of Supervisors are considering solely to focus on fecal matter. Wastewater surveillance is new. How does it work? Ms. Amy Kirby, PhD MPH, of the CDC's National Wastewater Surveillance System Program said it's based on PCR testing. PCR tests spun at higher rates than 27,000 rpms are useless. Over the last three years we learned that one can find any virus or bacteria in the material depending on higher spin cycles. We can expect Drs. Theresa Cullen, Fernando Garcia, and Matt Heinz to spin this into another emergency to scare the public into compliance, like they did for the last three years.

In August of 2022, NACCHO and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention CDC presented on the National Wastewater Surveillance System and three local jurisdictions shared their experiences and lessons learned. Tempe, Az was one of the local jurisdictions featured.

Ms. Amy Kirby, PhD MPH, [National Wastewater Surveillance System Program Lead, Waterborne Disease Prevention Branch, Division of Foodborne, Waterborne and Environmental Diseases Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)], said in a webinar: *“As long as they're using a toilet that's connected to a sewer system, we can get information on those cases through wastewater surveillance.”* And *“Over the past two years (in August 2022), they've collected over 83,000 unique wastewater samples in our data system over 1,200 sites that represents over 130 million people, that's representing 40% of the US population.”*

Supposedly, the Public Health department wants to track new variants of the SARS-CoV-2 virus.

I say, they are greedy for the “free” money. Reminder, you are abusing taxpayer money. It's not free!

Supposedly, the wastewater surveillance is serving as an early warning system for changes in COVID-19 burden in “vulnerable communities.” Let's be honest, this is race-based surveillance.

It's about the power to call up another “Emergency” when it's convenient in the next presidential

Election. It's about bankrupting of America to support the Administration's Communist revolution.
