Yes, due to revising the contract language to modify how workshops will be provided during the COVID-19 pandemic. The negative impact of not approving this amendment is adult, dislocated worker and youth job seekers would not be able to attend workforce development workshops for an additional year.

**AMENDMENT SIX****1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.****1.1 Background.**

- 1.1.1. On April 19, 2016, Pima County ("County") and Cope Community Service Inc. *dba* Rise, L.L.C. ("Awardee"), entered into the above-referenced contract to provide workshops for adults, dislocated workers, and youth.
- 1.1.2. County, as Grantee, receives federal WIOA grant funds and provides them to subrecipients, including Awardee, to provide eligible workforce development services. The WIOA grant ends June 30, 2023.
- 1.1.3. County is the Subrecipient of Health Profession Opportunity Grant ("HPOG") funds from Pima Community College and is authorized to pass those funds along to other entities, including Awardee.

1.2. County Organization. Effective July 1, 2020:

- 1.2.1. Pima County Community Services, Employment and Training Department and Pima County Community Development and Neighborhood Conservation Department are restructured to form the Community and Workforce Development Department.
- 1.2.2. This Agreement will be renumbered to CT-CR-20-408, but all terms and conditions remain unchanged.
- 1.2.3. Any reference in the Agreement to Community Services; Community Services, Employment and Training Department; or CSET, will mean Community and Workforce Development Department ("CWD").

1.3. Purpose.

- 1.3.1. County operates a workforce development program at Pima County ARIZONA@WORK (an American Job Center, formerly the Pima County One Stop).
- 1.3.2. County finds that it is in the best interests of the Pima County residents to continue to provide workforce development services to the residents of Pima County.
- 1.3.3. County has reviewed Awardee's performance of the services and finds it satisfactory.

2. TERMS AND EXTENSIONS, SECTION 1.0. Pursuant to paragraph 1.1, County is exercising the last available extension option. This Agreement will terminate on **June 30, 2021**.

3. COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT, SECTION 3.0 – is amended as follows:

3.1 Paragraph 3.1 is amended to increase "the Maximum Allocated Amount":

3.2 Paragraph 3.2, the table is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 3.13.1 The cost principles set forth in 2 CFR part 200, Subpart E, as may be modified by amendments and additions by the Awarding Agency set forth below, will be used to determine whether an incurred cost will be reimbursed under this Agreement:

3.13.2 Those costs which are specifically defined as unallowable by the funding source cannot be submitted for reimbursement by the Subrecipient and will not be reimbursed.

3.13.3 Awardee must reimburse County for improper, unallowable or unsubstantiated costs discovered as a result of audit or otherwise within thirty (30) days following demand for reimbursement by County.

4. **COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS, SECTION 6.0**, paragraph 6.2.3 is amended to read:

Lobbying to influence the outcome of any election or the award of any federal contract, grant, loan or cooperative agreement (see Federal Standard Form LLL, "Disclosure of Lobbying Activities);

6. **ISRAEL BOYCOTT CERTIFICATION, SECTION 33.0** is added to read:

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Contractor engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Contract has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Contractor certifies it is not currently engaged in, and agrees for the duration of this Contract to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.

7. **EXHIBIT A – SCOPE OF WORK, WORK STATEMENT** is amended as follows:

7.1 **PROGRAM OVERVIEW, SECTION 1**, paragraph 1.2 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

1.2 **Impact of COVID-19 on activities:**

1.2.1 During interruption of site-based services due to COVID-19, Workshops will be provided using on-line platforms. Additionally, one-on-one on-line and phone conferences will be provided, as needed, to assist clients with course work and to prepare resumes.

1.2.2 Workshops will be conducted at classroom locations determined by CSET, when it is safely possible according to County health officials, as will one-on-one assistance and résumé preparation.

7.2 **PROGRAM ACTIVITIES, SECTION 2** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2.1 Awardee will:

2.1.1 Provide Basic Computer Skills for Job Seekers workshops. Each workshop (whether in person or on-line) will meet for twenty (20) hours and will follow the curriculum outlined in Awardee's response to RFP CSET-WS-2015-09.

2.1.2 Ensure that each participant has an electronic résumé listed on Arizona Job Connection or its successor database.

2.2 County will, in its sole discretion, schedule each workshop, determine the workshop format (on-line, in person, or a combination of both) and determine the number of participants for each workshop.

7.3 BUDGET, SECTION 4, the table for July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021 is added to read:
