ORDINANCE NO. 2014 - ___, An ordinance of the Pima County Board of Supervisors, regulating parking on Michigan Street in Pima County, Arizona. Staff recommends **APPROVAL**. (District 2)

The reason for this ordinance is that Gem & Lapidary Wholesalers, Inc. requested that the City of Tucson parking prohibition be extended on the north and south side of Michigan Street from 260 feet east of Randolph Avenue to Palo Verde Road to eliminate parking encroachment of the travel lanes and to increase pedestrian safety during the summer and winter gem shows.



**AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF
SUPERVISORS REGULATING PARKING ON MICHIGAN
STREET IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-873, as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is in the interest of public safety that vehicles should not park anytime on the north or south side of Michigan Street from 260 feet east of Randolph Avenue (City of Tucson Limit) to Palo Verde Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. Parking on the north and south side of Michigan Street from 260 feet east of Randolph Avenue (City of Tucson Limit) to Palo Verde Road be posted No Parking Anytime.

SECTION 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
