## PIMA COUNTY RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE STADIUM DISTRICT BUDGET FISCAL YEAR 2021/2022

- 1. - The public hearing was duly held today, at the time and place designated in the published notice, at which any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the estimates of revenues and expenditures shown on the accompanying schedules are adopted as the budget of the District for the Fiscal Year 2021/2022.
