Requested Board Meeting Date: September 19, 2017

Title: Old Spanish Trail No Parking

Introduction/Background:

A restaurant is located on the northwest corner of Escalante Road and Old Spanish Trail. Onsite parking is limited for the restaurant, so some patrons park along the west side of Old Spanish Trail within Pima County right of way. Pima County Traffic Engineering received a citizen concern regarding limited sight distance as a result of these parked vehicles.

Discussion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering staff reviewed the intersection sight distance on Escalante Road and Old Spanish Trail as a result of the citizen request. The field review determined that parked vehicles on the west side of Old Spanish Trail, north of Escalante Road, limited the intersection sight distance for eastbound vehicles on Escalante Road and at the restaurant driveway. In the past five years, three crashes involving eastbound vehicles hitting southbound vehicles have occurred at the Escalante Road and Old Spanish Trail intersection. The general manager of the restaurant was notified of the proposal to prohibit parking, and he indicated that he is not opposed.

Conclusion:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends that a no-parking zone be established on the west side of Old Spanish Trail from Escalante Road to 300 feet north of Escalante Road. The no-parking zone will prevent intersection sight distance limitations from parked vehicles.

Recommendation:

Pima County Traffic Engineering recommends that the west side of Old Spanish Trail be established as No Parking from Escalante Road to 300 feet north of Escalante Road.

ORDINANCE NO. 2017-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS REGULATING PARKING ON OLD SPANISH TRAIL IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627 and 28-873, as amended, to regulate the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined that it is in the interest of public safety that vehicles should not park on the west side of Old Spanish Trail from Escalante Road to 300 feet north of Escalante Road,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. Parking on the west side of Old Spanish Trail from Escalante Road to 300 feet north of Escalante Road shall be regulated No Parking.

SECTION 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highway herein listed giving notice of the parking restriction.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.




