Dear Board of Supervisors,

I'm reaching out about item #10 on the addendum agenda for the September 19 meeting. Please vote in favor of allocating the surplus general fund ending balance toward affordable housing. This recommendation comes from the Regional Affordable Housing Commission, which voted unanimously at their August 18 meeting to forward this recommendation to the Board of Supervisors. Supervisor Heinz also supported the recommendation in his memo dated August 30.

When the status quo involves people making the median wage being unable to afford a median-priced apartment, leaders like you are obligated to intervene and use every possible tool and resource to address the problem. Immediate and urgent action is needed in order to address the housing crisis, and you have the opportunity to take meaningful action by approving this one-time expenditure of additional, unappropriated funds to go toward affordable housing.

I was 8 months pregnant when the county program dropped and I lost my daughter to the 2yr period of Dhs that required housing and there was none! I need to know my rights as a Woman and Mother are justified by making sure All Women get housing! I could not express the serious science of trauma we have to face in our communities that are underfunded and unregulated. If you are a father or noble of Our Forefathers please find it in your heart to understand this situation!!!~~~~~
