

Agenda Item #32. FEMA EFSP, National Board \$6,790,032.00 Humanitarian Relief Grant for "Asylum Seekers"

FEMA and Emergency Food and Shelter Program (EFSP) advanced \$6,790,032.00 to Pima County to cover costs of the Southern Border Operations Partnership to provide aid to "asylum seekers" to prevent street release and mitigate COVID-19 spread by providing food and shelter. The Southern Border Operations Partnership includes Pima County, City of Tucson, Catholic Community Services, and The Inn of Southern Arizona. The grant award began 3/1/2012 and was scheduled to end 4/30/2023, but Pima County requested an extension of the period of time in which all eligible expenses must be made to 12/31/2023. FEMA EFSP agreed to grant Pima County the extension and Pima County plans to continue to support the invasion of America with little regard to the safety and humanitarian needs of their own citizens here in Pima County.

Return these federal funds and focus on the Pima County residents instead of mismanaging federal taxpayer funds and county resources for "asylum seekers." Federal funds are not gifts—it is taxpayer money.
