

SUBAWARD AMENDMENT

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE.

- 1.1. <u>Background</u>. On May 7, 2019, the Pima County Board of Supervisors approved the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Annual Action Plan ("AAP") and Resolution No. 2019-31 for CDBG projects and CDBG funding use. Pima County and Subrecipient entered into the above referenced agreement on December 16, 2024 to complete facility improvements that will enable Subrecipient to provide additional resources and programming to the Ajo CDBG Target Area and surrounding area of unincorporated Pima County.
- 1.2. <u>Purpose</u>. Subrecipient requires an amendment to the term to complete project activity.
- 2. **TERM**. The County is exercising the first extension option to renew the contract for one additional year commencing on 07/01/2025 and terminating on 06/30/2026. If the commencement date is before the Effective Date of this amendment, the parties will, for all purposes, deem the amendment to have been in effect as of the commencement date.
- 3. **COUNTERPARTS**. This agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which, when taken together, will constitute one original agreement.

All other provisions of the Agreement not expressly modified in this Amendment will remain in effect and be binding on the parties.
