PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Adult and Juvenile Probation Departments and Pretrial Services Department are essential components of the Pima County criminal justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Adult and Juvenile Probation Departments and Pretrial Services Department uphold the law with dignity, while recognizing the right of the public to be safe-guarded from criminal activity; and

WHEREAS, these professionals each year supervise 8,169 adult probationers with a 78-percent success rate; evaluate 6,660 juvenile referrals and divert 68 percent of referred youth out of the court process; and use screening tools to help identify candidates for supervised pretrial release, resulting in a 50-percent reduction in the daily misdemeanor jail population; and

WHEREAS, these experts are trained professionals who provide essential services and referrals for offenders; and

WHEREAS, these professionals work in partnership with numerous community agencies and groups; and

WHEREAS, these professionals promote prevention, intervention and advocacy; and

WHEREAS, community corrections professionals provide services, support, and protection for victims;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors, hereby proclaims July 15 through 21, 2018, to be:

“PRETRIAL, PROBATION, AND COMMUNITY SUPERVISION WEEK”

and encourages all residents to honor these community corrections professionals and to recognize their achievements.
