OPERATION GREEN LIGHT WEEK – November 4 thru November 11, 2025

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the residents of Pima County have great respect, admiration, and gratitude for all the men and women who have selflessly served our country in the Armed Forces; and

WHEREAS, Pima County is committed to serving our military personnel, veterans and their families through the Kino Veterans Workforce Center and our dedicated staff that provide supportive services to them; and

WHEREAS, approximately 200,000 service members transition to civilian communities annually; and an estimated 20% increase of service members will transition to civilian life soon; and

WHEREAS, studies indicate that 44-72% of service members experience high levels of stress during this transition, and service members transitioning from military service are at a high risk for suicide during their first year after military service; and

WHEREAS, the National Association of Counties encourages all counties, parishes and boroughs to recognize Operation Green Light for Veterans, as a time to honor the service and sacrifices of those transitioning from active service.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims the week of November 4 through November 11, 2025, to be:

“OPERATION GREEN LIGHT WEEK”

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that in observance of Operation Green Light, Pima County is illuminating the Historic Courthouse green from November 4 through November 11, 2025, to remind the veterans and their families in our community that we are here for them; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Pima County encourages everyone to honor those who made immeasurable sacrifices to preserve freedom by displaying green lights in a window of their place of business or residence from November 4 through November 11, 2025.
