ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This amendment #1 will extend for five years the Intergovernmental Agreement between Pima County Regional Flood Control District and the U.S. Geological Survey, U.S. Department of Interior originally signed on July 1, 2008 for the purpose of streamflow analysis and stream gauge infrastructure installation and repair. The agreement allows Pima County Regional Flood Control District to contract with the U.S. Geological survey for reconstruction of damaged stream gauges and assistance in establishing new stream gauges. The amendment provides for an additional \$25,000 to be added to the contract.



The Joint Funding Agreement 08W4AZ03900 between the U.S. Geological Survey and Pima County ending June 30, 2013, is hereby amended as follows:

1. Paragraph 2. (a) of the Joint Funding Agreement is hereby amended to extend the period of performance to June 30, 2018.
2. Paragraph 2. (b) of the Joint Funding Agreement is hereby increased from \$50,000 TO \$75,000. This Amendment reflects an increase of \$25,000 from Pima County. The period of performance is extended to June 30, 2018.
3. All other provisions of the Joint Funding Agreement remain unchanged.
