Agenda Item 28. \$2,891,391.00 for Catholic Community Services of Southern Arizona, Inc., to provide for Fiscal Agent Pima County/Emergency food and shelter.

Agenda Item 29. \$823,000.00 for the City of Tucson, to provide Fiscal Agent Pima County / Emergency food and shelter to families and individuals.

Agenda Item 30. \$135,148.00 for The Inn of Southern, Arizona Inc., to provide Fiscal Agent Pima County / Emergency food and shelter to families and individuals.

Agenda Item 31. \$750,000.00 for SJM Premier Medical Group, L.L.C., Amendment No. 6, to provide COVID-19 medical support for refugee populations.

Agenda Item 45.\$3,395,015.87 for food, shelter, and other humanitarian support to "asylum seekers" at Casa Alitas Welcome Center, Comfort Suites, and Red Roof Inn.
