PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, on March 18, 1963, nearly 60 years ago, the U.S. Supreme Court, in Gideon v. Wainwright, held that the Sixth Amendment right to appointed counsel applies to the states through the 14th Amendment; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to this ruling, those facing criminal charges with the possibility of imprisonment must be appointed an attorney if they cannot afford one; and

WHEREAS, our legal system is based on the principles of equity, fairness, due process of the law, equal protection under the law, innocence until proven guilty, and, since this landmark ruling, a person's right to have an attorney defend them in criminal prosecutions, even if they are unable to afford one; and

WHEREAS, Pima County Public Defense Services attorneys, paralegals, legal secretaries, clerks, investigators and social workers continue to work tirelessly to provide essential constitutionally guaranteed legal services to those who otherwise would not have them; and

WHEREAS, Public Defense Services, in representing its clients, upholds the rights set forth in the U.S. Constitution of every accused person to have a fair trial or obtain a just result from the legal process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Saturday, March 18, 2023, to be:

"PUBLIC DEFENSE DAY"
