ITEM SUMMARY, JUSTIFICATION &/or SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

Background

Pima County received an H1-B Technical Skills Training Grant from the U. S. Department of Labor to:

1. Provide training for 200 incumbent, i.e. existing workers in southern Arizona;
2. Train workers to move up into positions for which employers are currently using the H-1B nonimmigrant visa program to hire foreign workers;
3. Expand the existing pipeline of home-grown, high-tech talent in the region;
4. Capitalize on recent innovations increasing workers' access to higher education;
5. Increase the diversity of the high-tech workforce;
6. Target workers employed at the technician level in engineering, information technology and related management;
7. Focus on small, high-tech companies that offer opportunities for advancement;
8. Support job creation and retention in the Aerospace/Defense sector and other high-tech industries.
