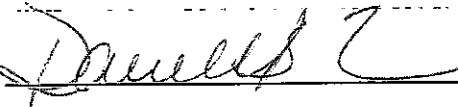

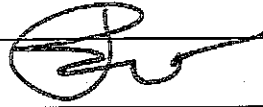

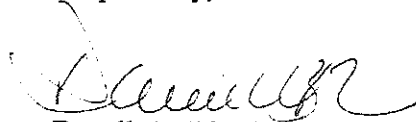

WHEREAS, whenever possible and without sacrificing child safety, keeping Arizona families together is an important goal for our communities and is the best option for a permanent, safe, and loving home for many children in foster care; and

WHEREAS, reunification takes hard work, commitment, and investment of time and resources by parents, family members, social workers, foster parents, service providers, attorneys, courts, educators, and the community; and

WHEREAS, for many years, many jurisdictions in the United States, including Arizona, have been celebrating the accomplishments of families who have overcome an array of challenges to reunify safely and successfully; and

WHEREAS, Governor Katie Hobbs has proclaimed June as Family Reunification Month; and

WHEREAS, Family Reunification Day in Pima County, on June 13, 2026, is an opportunity to recognize families who have successfully overcome the challenges that brought their children into out-of-home care.
