I humbly request that you please review the attached paperwork relating to our request to abate the property taxes that our church was invoiced for the years 2019, 2020 and 2021 on 3601 W Cromwell Drive Tucson, AZ 85741-2030, parcel number 225-39-0070.

We had previously submitted the paperwork on February 1, 2022 to the Clerk of the Board, but accidently sent in the incorrect letter leaving the year 2021 out. We kindly ask you to please take this letter instead of the one that we submitted with the documents.

I have been working with an accountant for the past three years to register our parcel as exempt for property tax purposes, but his attempts have so far not been successful for an unknown reason to me. I had previously submitted the exempt application for the whole property, but just came to find out that the property is split into two parcels. The application that we submitted for the property tax exemption was approved, but this parcel was not included in the application.

I come from a modest background and am not familiar with a lot of the terms used in a governmental and financial context but have asked a new accountant to help me understand everything that I am required to send to you.

I thank you in advance for the time you are taking to consider this petition and will be glad to answer any further questions you may have on this case.

BYLAWS OF IGLESIA DE JESUCRISTO PALABRA MIEL TUCSON

The name of the organization is Iglesia de Jesucristo Palabra Miel Tucson. The organization is organized in accordance with the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act, as amended. The organization has not been formed for the making of any profit, or personal financial gain. The assets and income of the organization shall not be distributable to, or benefit the trustees, directors, or officers or other individuals. The assets and income shall only be used to promote corporate purposes as described below. Nothing contained herein, however, shall be deemed to prohibit the payment of reasonable compensation to employees and independent contractors for services provided for the benefit of the organization. This organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax. The organization shall not endorse, contribute to, work for, or otherwise support (or oppose) a candidate for public office. The organization is organized exclusively for purposes subsequent to section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

ARTICLE I MEETINGS

Section 1. <u>Annual Meeting</u>. An annual meeting shall be held once each calendar year for the purpose of electing directors and for the transaction of such other business as may properly come before the meeting. The annual meeting shall be held at the time and place designated by the Board of Directors from time to time.

Section 2. <u>Special Meetings</u>. Special meetings maybe be requested by the President or the Board of Directors. A special meeting of members is not required to be held at a geographic location if the meeting is held by means of the internet of other electronic communications technology in a manner pursuant to which the members have the opportunity to read or hear the proceedings substantially concurrent with the occurrence of the proceedings, note on matters submitted to the members, pose questions, and make comments.

Section 3. <u>Notice</u>. Written notice of all meetings shall be provided under this section or as otherwise required by law. The Notice shall state the place, date, and hour of meeting, and if for a special meeting, the purpose of the meeting. Such notice shall be mailed to all directors of record at the address shown on the corporate books, at least 10 days prior to the meeting. Such notice shall be deemed effective when deposited in ordinary U.S. mail, properly addressed, with postage prepaid.

Section 4. <u>Place of Meeting</u>. Meetings shall be held at the organization's principal place of business unless otherwise stated in the notice. Unless the articles of incorporation or bylaws provide otherwise, the board of directors may permit any or all directors to participate in a

regular or special meeting by, or conduct the meeting through the use of, any means of communication by which all directors participating may simultaneously hear each other during this meeting. A director participating in a meeting by this means shall be deemed to be present in person at the meeting.

Section 5. Quorum. A majority of the directors shall constitute at quorum at a meeting. In the absence of a quorum, a majority of the directors may adjourn the meeting to another time without further notice. If a quorum is represented at an adjourned meeting, any business may be transacted that might have been transacted at the meeting as originally scheduled. The directors present at a meeting represented by a quorum may continue to transact business until adjournment, even if the withdrawal of some directors results in representation of less than a quorum.

Section 6. <u>Informal Action</u>. Any action required to be taken, or which may be taken, at a meeting, may be taken without a meeting and without prior notice if a consent in writing, setting forth the action so taken, is signed by the directors with respect to the subject matter of the vote.

ARTICLE II DIRECTORS

Section 1. <u>Number of Directors</u>. The organization shall be managed by a Board of Directors consisting of 02 director(s).

Section 2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting. Each director shall serve a term of 20 year(s), or until a successor has been elected and qualified.

Section 3. Quorum. A majority of directors shall constitute a quorum.

Section 4. <u>Adverse Interest</u>. In the determination of a quorum of the directors, or in voting, the disclosed adverse interest of a director shall not disqualify the director or invalidate his or her vote.

Section 5. <u>Regular Meeting</u>. The Board of Directors shall meet immediately after the election for the purpose of electing its new officers, appointing new committee chairpersons and for transacting such other business as may be deemed appropriate. The Board of Directors may provide, by resolution, for additional regular meetings without notice other than the notice provided by the resolution.

Section 6. <u>Special Meeting</u>. Special meetings may be requested by the President, Vice-President, Secretary, or any two directors by providing five days' written notice by ordinary United States mail, effective when mailed. Minutes of the meeting shall be sent to the Board of Directors within two weeks after the meeting. A special meeting of members is not required to be held at a geographic location if the meeting is held by means of the internet of other electronic communications technology in a manner pursuant to which the members have the opportunity to read or hear the proceedings substantially concurrent with the occurrence of the proceedings, note on matters submitted to the members, pose questions, and make comments.

Section 7. <u>Procedures</u>. The vote of a majority of the directors present at a properly called meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Directors, unless the vote of a greater number is required by law or by these by-laws for a particular resolution. A director of the organization who is present at a meeting of the Board of Directors at which action on any corporate matter is taken shall be presumed to have assented to the action taken unless their dissent shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting. The Board shall keep written minutes of its proceedings in its permanent records.

Section 8. <u>Informal Action</u>. Any action required to be taken at a meeting of directors, or any action which may be taken at a meeting of directors or of a committee of directors, may be taken without a meeting if a consent in writing setting forth the action so taken, is signed by all of the directors or all of the members of the committee of directors, as the case may be.

Section 9. <u>Removal / Vacancies</u>. A director shall be subject to removal, with or without cause, at a meeting called for that purpose. Any vacancy that occurs on the Board of Directors, whether by death, resignation, removal or any other cause, may be filled by the remaining directors. A director elected to fill a vacancy shall serve the remaining term of his or her predecessor, or until a successor has been elected and qualified.

Section 10. <u>Committees</u>. To the extent permitted by law, the Board of Directors may appoint from its members a committee or committees, temporary or permanent, and designate the duties, powers and authorities of such committees.

ARTICLE III OFFICERS

Section 1. <u>Number of Officers</u>. The officers of the organization shall be a President, one or more Vice-Presidents (as determined by the Board of Directors), a Treasurer, and a Secretary. Two or more offices may be held by one person. The President may not serve concurrently as a Vice President.

President/Chairman. The President shall be the chief executive officer and shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors and its Executive Committee, if such a committee is created by the Board.

Vice President. The Vice President shall perform the duties of the President in the absence of the President and shall assist that office in the discharge of its leadership duties.

Secretary. The Secretary shall give notice of all meetings of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee, shall keep an accurate list of the directors, and shall have the authority to certify any records, or copies of records, as the official records of the

organization. The Secretary shall maintain the minutes of the Board of Directors' meetings and all committee meetings.

Treasurer/CFO. The Treasurer shall be responsible for conducting the financial affairs of the organization as directed and authorized by the Board of Directors and Executive Committee, if any, and shall make reports of corporate finances as required, but no less often than at each meeting of the Board of Directors and Executive Committee.

Section 2. <u>Election and Term of Office</u>. The officers shall be elected annually by the Board of Directors at the first meeting of the Board of Directors, immediately following the annual meeting. Each officer shall serve a one year term or until a successor has been elected and qualified.

Section 3. <u>Removal or Vacancy</u>. The Board of Directors shall have the power to remove an officer or agent of the organization. Any vacancy that occurs for any reason may be filled by the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE IV CORPORATE SEAL, EXECUTION OF INSTRUMENTS

The organization shall not have a corporate seal. All instruments that are executed on behalf of the organization which are acknowledged and which affect an interest in real estate shall be executed by the President or any Vice-President and the Secretary or Treasurer. All other instruments executed by the organization, including a release of mortgage or lien, may be executed by the President or any Vice-President. Notwithstanding the preceding provisions of this section, any written instrument may be executed by any officer(s) or agent(s) that are specifically designated by resolution of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V AMENDMENT TO BYLAWS

The bylaws may be amended, altered, or repealed by the Board of Directors by a majority of a quorum vote at any regular or special meeting. The text of the proposed change shall be distributed to all board members at least ten (10) days before the meeting.

ARTICLE VI INDEMNIFICATION

Any director or officer who is involved in litigation by reason of his or her position as a director or officer of this organization shall be indemnified and held harmless by the organization to the fullest extent authorized by law as it now exists or may subsequently be amended (but, in the case of any such amendment, only to the extent that such amendment permits the organization to provide broader indemnification rights).

ARTICLE VII DISSOLUTION

The organization may be dissolved only with authorization of its Board of Directors given at a special meeting called for that purpose, and with the subsequent approval by no less than two-thirds (2/3) vote of the members. In the event of the dissolution of the organization, the assets shall be applied and distributed as follows:

All liabilities and obligations shall be paid, satisfied and discharged, or adequate provision shall be made therefore. Assets not held upon a condition requiring return, transfer, or conveyance to any other organization or individual shall be distributed, transferred, or conveyed, in trust or otherwise, to charitable and educational organization, organized under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, of a similar or like nature to this organization, as determined by the Board of Directors.

Our church was acquired on November 21st, 2016. This property that was acquired for church consists of 2 different parcels, the parcel where the church building is at is the parcel that is next to this one.

This parcel is mostly open land that the church has and the two small buildings that are in this parcel consists of:

1. THE BARN

The main function of the barn is as a storage unit for the church. Here is where we store all of the extra equipment, we use for the functions that we have inside of the church building. Below we have listed all the church activities that we have within the church building and with those activities we have equipment bought to serve the community within the best possibilities. We store extra chairs used in the church building, extra instruments used in the worship team and for the music school, extra tables used for fellowship, and utensils used for the breakfast. The church also has extra light bulbs and basic repair supplies here for the church building. About 96% of our total time is allocated to this storage unit. This storage unit is funded by the donations from the members. This storage unit allows members of the church to always have on hand what is needed for any functions that the church may have.

2. 2nd BUILDING

The 2nd building is used as an extra storage space when the barn is full. Many times, depending on the activities the church has we need extra space to store equipment or supplies. Having everything organized and visible to the members when going into the storage unit is important. About 4% of our total time is allocated to this building. This 2nd storage is funded by the donations from the members. This building helps members have everything organized.

Here is a list of the activities we hold in our church building to see the movement that the church has and the importance of this parcel which consists of storage.

1. HOLD REGULAR SERVICES OF WORSHIP AND TEACHING

Congregation gathers together at the temple on Friday at 7:30 PM and Sundays at 4:00 PM to worship God for about an hour. The worship is led by worship team comprised of members of the church. Then the Pastor shares a teaching of the Word of God (Bible) for about an hour. Finally, an elder of the church provides the announcements for the week before dismissing the church reunion. Members of the

church will then have the option to stay after the service to have fellowship with other members of the church. Activities will be held at the church temple twice a week and executed by the worship team and Pastor. About 44% of our total time is allocated to this activity. The activity is funded by donations from the members. This activity allows members of the church to grow closer relationship to God through worship and through the knowledge of His Word.

2. HOLD PRAYER SERVICES

Congregation gathers together at the temple on Monday at 7:00 PM for prayer. Members can pray at their seats or at the alter (upon personal preference) to God. The prayer will be an hour long. Depending on the environment and willingness of the members, the Pastor may decide to share a small doctrinal teaching of the Word or lead the members into further prayer. Members of the church will then have the option to stay after the service to have fellowship with other members of the church. Activities will be held at the church temple and executed by the Pastor. About 22% of our total time is allocated to this activity. The activity is funded by donations from the members. The activity provides a place where people can seek God and find refuge from the day-to-day mundane matters of this world.

3. MUSIC CLASSES FOR MEMBERS WHO WANT TO JOIN THE WORSHIP TEAM

Members and any other individual who wants to learn how to play an instrument/ sing join at the temple at 10:00 AM on Saturdays where current members of the worship team teach and guide those who want to learn or improve upon their musical/ singing skills for two hours. At noon, there will be an intermediate break for an hour. Then at 1 PM, the classes will resume until 2 PM. Activity will be held at the church temple and executed by the worship team. About 22% of our total time is allocated to this activity. The activity is funded by the donations collected during regular and prayer services. The activity ensures that we give the opportunity to everyone to join the worship team have a strong worship team, which is fundamental part of our faith.

4. BREAKFAST COMMUNION

Members of the church will gather at the temple once a week on Sundays to have communion with the other members of the church while eating breakfast at 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Ten volunteers from the church will prepare a breakfast plate and other members arrive and give a donation of their choice to participate in the breakfast. The donation collected will be used to offset the costs involved in the cost of the food and all extra money will be used to cover administrative costs (utility bills, overhead, etc.). Activity will be held at the church temple in the foyer area and will be executed by volunteer members of the church. About 6% of our total time is allocated to this activity. The activity will foment a healthy community environment within the church and allows the body of Christ to participate in fellowship as taught by the Bible.

5. HOLD YOUTH SERVICES

Young members of the church (12 years old and above, unmarried) will gather at the temple once a month to worship God for about an hour. The worship team comprised of youth members of the church will lead this part of the service. Then the Pastor shares a teaching of the Word of God that is applicable for youth members for about an hour. An elder then dismisses the reunion with a prayer. Activities will be held at the church temple about once a month at the discretion of the Pastor and executed by the

worship team and the Pastor. About 6% of our total time is allocated to this activity. The activity is funded by the donations from the members. The activity helps youth members acquire the knowledge and wisdom of God to make fundamental decisions in this critical period of their life according to God's will and Word.
