WHEREAS, Prince Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church continues to carry a message of Faith, Grace and Praise.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Pima County Board of Supervisors hereby proclaims Sunday, November 22, 2015, to be:
