I would like to thank you for directing an inquiry to the Sheriff, County Attorney and Public Defense Director seeking information and data related to additional costs that may arise through the acceptance, use and administration of the OPSG related to Pima County Adult Detention Center detention, prosecution of border-related and drug smuggling crime by the County Attorney and the cost of public defense of non-citizens provided by our public defense agency.

As such, I am requesting the same information you requested now be provided for the prior three Stonegarden grant awards including:

1. GTAW 17-39: Stonegarden Grant Award for \$1,176,208 (Final Action by the BOS on 12/13/16);
2. GTAW 16-51: Stonegarden Grant Award for \$1,184,528 (Final Action by the BOS on 1/19/16); and
3. GTAW 15-55: Stonegarden Grant Award for \$1,197,828 (Final Action by the BOS on 1/20/2015)

The information I am requesting will assist in review of the current Stonegarden grant award discussion. Additionally, in reviewing prior year additional costs, we will be able to have a meaningful discussion with concrete data.
