PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Pima County Board of Supervisors recognizes the month of June 2025 as Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ+) “Pride Month” throughout Pima County; and

WHEREAS, Pima County honors the history of the LGBTQ+ liberation movement and supports the rights of all citizens to experience equality and freedom from discrimination; and

WHEREAS, LGBTQ+ individuals have had immeasurable impact to the cultural, civic, and economic successes of our country, and while society at large increasingly supports LGBTQ+ equality, the need for education and awareness remains vital; and

WHEREAS, this nation was founded on the principle that every individual has dignity and worth, and the Pima County Board of Supervisors calls upon the residents of our community to embrace this principle and work to eliminate prejudice everywhere it exists; and

WHEREAS, celebrating Pride Month brings awareness and provides support and advocacy for Pima County’s LGBTQ+ community, and is an opportunity to take action and engage in dialogue to strengthen alliances, build acceptance, and advance equal rights, an urgent need in our community and country.
