Title: Camino Verde Speed Limit Ordinance

Introduction/Background:

Camino Verde was extended from Brightwater Way/Valley Stream Drive to Valencia Road as part of an improvement project. The existing Ordinance, 2013-49, which establishes the posted speed for segments of Camino Verde, does not contain this new segment.

Discussion:

The Camino Verde extension provides additional access for residents of the Star Valley subdivision to Valencia Road. This segment was designed based on a 35 mph posted speed limit.

Conclusion:

The speed limit for the extension is consistent with the 35 mph speed limit from Brightwater Way/Valley Stream Drive south to Los Reales Road/Wade Road. Speed limit signs designating the segment as 35 mph are currently installed.

Recommendation:

Pima County Traffic Engineering is recommending approval of this ordinance to designate the segment of Camino Verde Road from Brightwater Way/Valley Stream Drive to Valencia Road with a 35 mph posted speed limit. Previous ordinance 2013-49 is recommended to be repealed, and the speed limits on the remaining portions of Camino Verde are recommended to remain.

ORDINANCE NO. 2016-__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ESTABLISHING PRIMA FACIE REASONABLE SPEED LIMITS FOR MOTOR VEHICLES ON PORTIONS OF CAMINO VERDE IN PIMA COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has the authority under Title 28 of the Arizona Revised Statutes, more specifically Sections 28-627, 28-701 and 28-703, as amended, to fix prima facie reasonable speed limits on through highways, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, has determined the prima facie reasonable speed limits for motor vehicles on portions of Camino Verde,

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

SECTION 1. The reasonable and safe prima facie speed limit for motor vehicles on Camino Verde shall be established as follows:

<u>SPEED LIMIT</u>	<u>FROM</u>	<u>TO</u>
a) 35 mph	Los Reales Road	Valencia Road
b) 45 mph	Valencia Road	Nebraska Street
c) 35 mph	Nebraska Street	Bopp Road

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2013-49 is repealed and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are superseded to the extent of such conflicts.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect when and to the extent that signs are posted on the highways herein listed giving notice of the prima facie reasonable speed limits.

SECTION 4. Violators of this ordinance shall be subject to civil or criminal sanctions as provided by law.

SECTION 5. The various county officers and employees are authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this ordinance.
