PROMISSORY NOTE

- 1. **Definitions**. The following capitalized terms, as used in this document, have the meanings assigned below:
 - 1.1. Closing Date: December 31, 2023.
 - 1.2. County: Pima County, Arizona, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona.
 - 1.3. **Interest**: interest on the unpaid Principal, accruing at the rate of 5.5% per annum from the Closing Date until fully paid.
 - 1.4. **Maturity Date**: the 3rd anniversary of the Closing Date.
 - 1.5. **Note**: this Promissory Note which has been issued a unique contract number, CT2400000026.
 - 1.6. **Maker**: Young Men's Christian Association of Metropolitan Tucson, an Arizona nonprofit corporation.
 - 1.7. **Operator Agreement**: that certain Operating Agreement, under former County contract number 11-04-Y-130852-0699 and current County contract number CT-PR-24-0340, including all amendments, between Maker and County, concerning the lease and operation of the Property by Maker.
 - 1.8. **Principal**: the principal sum due under this Note, which is in the amount of \$259.920.00.
- 2. **Promise to Pay**. For value received, Maker promises to pay to County the Principal and Interest as provided in this Note.
- 3. **Principal and Interest Payments**. Subject to the provisions of <u>Section 6</u> below regarding prepayment of the Principal, and the provisions of <u>Section 8</u> below regarding the rights and remedies of County upon the occurrence of an Event of Default, Maker will make payments of Principal and Interest to the County, as provided in the payment schedule attached as **Exhibit A**.
- 4. **Application of Payments**. All amounts payable under this Note must be paid in legal tender of the United States of America. Acceptance by County of any payment in an amount less than the amount then due under this Note will not constitute an accord and satisfaction, but merely a payment on account. County will apply all payments made under this Note in the following order of priority: (a) first, to any late charges, costs, fees, interest, or other amounts then due and payable to County under this Note (other than the Principal); and (b) to the payment of the Principal.
- 5. Late Charge & Overdue Interest Rate. Maker recognizes that, should any payment required by this Note not be paid when due, County will incur extra expenses for the handling of delinquent payments, the exact amount of which is impossible to ascertain, but that a charge equal to 10% of the amount due is a fair approximation of those expenses. Maker therefore agrees to pay a late payment fee of 10% of any payment that is not delivered to County within five business days after its due date. In addition, overdue

- amounts owned under this Note will bear interest from the date due until paid at the rate of 6% per annum.
- 6. **Optional Prepayments**. Maker may voluntarily prepay all or any portion of the Principal balance at any time, and from time to time, without any prepayment penalty, cost or expense of any kind whatsoever. All such prepayments will be applied in the manner provided in <u>Section 4 above</u>, and the amount applied to the payment of Principal will be applied in the inverse order of maturity.
- 7. Collection Procedures, Waiver of Notice. Maker (for itself and its successors and assigns), and each endorser and guarantor of this Note by virtue of its endorsement or guaranty, hereby waives grace, notice, notice of default, notice of intent to accelerate, notice of acceleration, protest, demand, presentment for payment and diligence in the collection of this Note, and in the filing of suit; and agrees that its liability will not be affected or impaired by any release or change in the security provided for Maker's obligations under this Note, or by any modification, renewal or extension of those obligations.
- 8. **Default**. Upon the occurrence of any of the following acts, omissions, or events (each an "**Event of Default**"), the Principal of this Note, together with all other amounts outstanding under this Note will, at the written option of County, be immediately due and payable:
 - 8.1. Maker fails to make any payment of Principal or Interest due under this Note (but inclusive of any applicable grace periods), whether at maturity, by acceleration, or otherwise, in accordance with the terms of this Note.
 - 8.2. Maker fails to pay any late charges, costs, fees or other amounts then due and payable to County under this Note (other than the Principal or Interest payments referenced in <u>subsection 8.1</u> above) in accordance with the terms of this Note or before five business days after Maker's receipt of written notice from County of such non-payment.
 - 8.3. Maker violates or fails to perform any other restriction or obligation punctually and properly under this Note or the Deed of Trust after any applicable grace, notice, or cure period.
 - 8.4. Any representation or warranty of Maker set forth in this Note or the Operating Agreement turns out to have been false or misleading in any material respect when made.
- 9. **Delay in Exercising Rights**. No delay or omission on the part of County in exercising any right under this Note will operate as a waiver of such right or any other rights. To the extent permitted by law, Maker waives the right in any action under this Note to assert that such action was not commenced within the time required by law. No failure by County to insist upon, nor any election by County not to insist upon, strict performance by Maker of any of any obligation under this Note will estop County from insisting on such strict performance in the future.
- 10. Costs of Enforcement. Maker agrees to pay to County on demand all reasonable expenses or other costs, including attorneys' fees and expert witness fees, incurred by County in connection with the successful enforcement or collection against Maker of any obligation under this Note, or in connection with any successful litigation or proceeding instituted by County.

11. **Payments and Notices**. All payments (unless arrangements are made for electronic payments) and notices required or permitted to be given under this Note must be in writing and delivered personally or mailed, postage prepaid, by registered or certified United States mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the relevant Party at the address set forth below:

Either Party may change its address for notice purposes by giving notice of the address change to the other Party in accordance with this section.

- 12. **Binding on Successors and Assigns**. The covenants and agreements contained in this Note bind the successors and assigns of Maker.
- 13. **Severability**. If any provision of this Note is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, this Note will be construed as not containing that provision, and all other provisions of this Note will remain in full force and effect, and to this end the provisions of this Note are declared to be severable.
