INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, COUNTY and COURT entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement for services as referenced above; and

WHEREAS, COURT and COUNTY, pursuant to Section 6, Term, have agreed to extend the term of the Intergovernmental Agreement for a period of two years; and

WHEREAS, COURT and COUNTY have agreed to increase the total payment amount to allow payment pursuant to Section 5 of the Intergovernmental Agreement for the continued provision of juvenile work crews to clean up public areas, maintain County parks and facilities and eradicate graffiti for the County during the extended term of the Intergovernmental Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

CHANGE SECTION 2.8

From: "A Work crew will consist of court-involved youth ordered to participate in community services as part of a restitution component of their probation requirements; crews will consist of two (2) Surveillance Officers for up to (10) youth; for up to a five (5) hour work day".

To: "A Work crew will consist of court-involved youth ordered to participate in community services as part of a restitution component of their probation requirements. Work crews will contain two (2) Surveillance Officers for up to (10) youths. A Work crew will report for duty only if the crew contains a minimum of two youths and the crew is capable of performing at least ten (10) hours of service that day."

CHANGE SECTION 5

Original agreement as amended provided for a reimbursement amount not to exceed \$110,000. This amendment increases the not to exceed amount to \$160,000.

DELETE Section 5.3 in its entirety.

SECTION 6.2

From: "This Agreement may be extended for additional two (2) one-year periods, or any lesser term as may be agreed upon, by formal amendment executed by the parties."...

To: "This Agreement is extended for a period of two (2) years and terminates on the 30th day of June, 2020."

The effective date of this Amendment shall be May 15, 2018.

All other provisions of the Intergovernmental Agreement not specifically changed by this Amendment, shall remain in effect and be binding upon the parties.


