The purpose of the Resolution and Order is to add a segment of Camino Verde Road from Valencia Road to one half mile south of Valencia Road (Brightwater Way) to the list of impact fee eligible projects within the Southwest Benefit Area. Constructing this segment of roadway will allow for a secondary access from the Star Valley neighborhood onto Valencia Road. Currently the residents of Star Valley only have a single access into their neighborhood via Wade Road. The secondary connection provided by Camino Verde is needed due to the increasing traffic volumes in the area. (All Districts)

# **RESOLUTION NO. 2013 -**

A RESOLUTION OF THE PIMA COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ADDING THE SEGMENT OF CAMINO VERDE ROAD SOUTH OF VALENCIA ROAD AS AN IMPACT FEE ELIGIBLE PROJECT WITHIN THE SOUTHWEST BENEFIT AREA (All Districts)

**WHEREAS**, on August 19, 1996, the Pima County Board of Supervisors ("the Board") approved the Pima County Roadway Development Fee Ordinance, adopted by Pima County Ordinance Number 1996-09 and codified as Title 19 of the Pima County Code, which established a roadway impact fee for those benefit areas established by the Board, and

**WHEREAS,** on October 9, 2009, the Board established the Southwest Benefit Area by Pima County Ordinance Number 2009-94 and identified specific roadway projects within the Southwest Benefit Area, and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that in order to provide for the proper flow and circulation of traffic in the southwest area of the county it is necessary to modify the list of impact fee projects identified in the Southwest Benefit Area,

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of Pima County, Arizona, that:

Section 1. Camino Verde Road from Valencia Road to one half mile south of Valencia Road shall be added to the list of impact fee eligible projects within the Southwest Benefit Area.

Section 2. The appropriate county officers and employees are hereby authorized and directed to perform all acts necessary or desirable to give effect to this resolution.
