Re: FY 2025-2026 RECOMMENDATIONS FOR OUTSIDE AGENCY PROGRAM -

ATTRACTIONS & TOURISM YEAR ONE FUNDING

Background

The Outside Agency Citizen Review Committee (the Committee) is a panel of six members appointed by the Board of Supervisors and County Administrator to serve as their representatives. The Community and Workforce Development (CWD) staff this Committee along with staff from the Pima County Department of Attractions & Tourism (A&T). Duties and responsibilities of the Committee are to review and make funding recommendations on A&T supported Outside Agencies (OA), which services include hospitality, attraction venues and tours, event settings, accommodations, food and beverages, souvenir sales, sporting events and community art integration for tourists and residents. Upon request, the Committee also reviews and makes recommendations for other County departments that administer and contract OA funds for Board consideration.

Discussion

Outside Agency funds are made available on a two-year funding cycle. In FY 2024-25, A&T issued the current bi-annual Request for Proposals, via the ZoomGrants online application system. Per the two-year OA process, FY 2024-25 is considered the "off cycle year" where previous year agencies do not re-apply for funding. Still, the Committee reviews the progress of all funded programs and invites specific agencies to make presentations if there are any programmatic, fiscal, or contractual issues that may require further assessment, discussion, or recommendations to staff to provide technical assistance. Pursuant to special requests or circumstances, the Committee assumed level funding for the Outside Agency Program for the Pima County FY 2025-26 Budget.

For FY 2025-26 OA funds, the Committee held two open public meetings in April and May 2025. Agencies made presentations to the Committee to discuss the progress of their new or existing programs, in addition to, a review of their respective budgets and contractual obligations. A record 34 agencies applied for funding with eleven new applications over prior year requests.

FY 2025-25 OA Committee Recommendations

Currently, the Committee is recommending year one, FY 2025-26 OA funds to twenty-four (24) agencies totaling \$427,500.00.

Conclusion

The Committee employs a public process that is community based and transparent; it is an extraordinary practice. Each Committee member recognizes their individual responsibility to evaluate the community needs of Pima County to make informed, appropriate, and reasonable recommendations to the Board of Supervisors for valued Outside Agency resources. The Committee has embraced the use of the ZoomGrants online application, which has significantly improved and added efficiency to OA review and monitoring process. Finally, the Committee would like to thank the CWD and Attractions & Tourism staff for their community knowledge and expertise in supporting the OA Committee's mission and purpose.
