Without a crosstown freeway for commuters we have a freeway most of the day on River Road. The property owners are feeling more and more trapped in the neighborhoods as it gets more and more difficult to make a left turn out of the neighborhoods along River Rd. We already have increased traffic from the new Basis North school and the new Quicktrip on the corner. I believe that the proposed rezoning Co 9-13-16 Sabino Canyon Prop. LLC. at Sabino Canyon road from SR to CR should be denied because of the higher density,

and increase of traffic on our main rd. of egress from our neighborhoods, both north and south of River Road. We need some kind of traffic control on River so that it is safer. I used to walk the neighborhood in the morning, and was almost run over by a motorcycle in Feb.that was hidden behind a car. The cyclist swerved around in front of me! The high school students that go to Sabino also have to cross River Road in the dark. I am so glad I don't have children taking their lives in their hands every morning to go to school! Anyway no rezoning until there is a solution to our traffic problems on"The River Freeway" Thank you, Linda Kyle
