

#### Dear Steve:

The Arizona Companion Animal Spay/Neuter Committee has reviewed all grant applications. One hundred and eight (108) programs will benefit from the \$835,465 disbursed for the 2025-2026 Grant Period.

We are happy to share that you have been selected to receive grant funds restricted to increasing spay and neuter efforts in your community in the amount of \$10,000 for your Community Cat Spay/Neuter program. These funds must be used for spay/neuter surgeries only.

Grant funds were made available from the support and sales of the Arizona Companion Animal Spay and Neuter Pet Friendly License Plates, voluntary contributions by Arizona residents through personal income tax returns and a special allocation of funding from the state budget thanks to Senator John Kavanagh's efforts.\* As such, we ask that you promote the Spay and Neuter License Plates and AZ Personal Income Tax Return Donation option through newsletters, websites, and media events. We encourage you and your staff to purchase the plates for your vehicles, too.

Grant Terms: Funds may be utilized from the date of this approval notice thru August 15, 2026.
