
IF DENIED: Without sufficient judicial resources, the Court would be unable to adequately serve the public.

IT IS ORDERED that the following designated persons be, and the same hereby are, appointed Justice of the Peace Pro Tempore for the Consolidated, Green Valley and Ajo Justice Courts, Pima County, Arizona, from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025. This appointment limits the exercise of the powers granted under A.R.S. § 22-121 to those occasions where the Pro Tempore Justice of the Peace is scheduled on the Pima County Consolidated, Green Valley or Ajo Justice Court docket and not for any other purpose or function, whether mandatory or discretionary.
