Title: Chuck Catino Community Leadership Award

# Introduction/Background:

This award originated with the Parks and Recreation Commission to honor Chuck Catino, longtime volunteer and founder of the Born Again Jocks Association -B.A.J.A. and the driver behind Canoa Preserve Park, in Green Valley, where the softball complex is named in his honor. This award recognizes outstanding volunteers who work with NRPR to meet the recreational needs of the community. Nominees must be 45 years of age or older and have a strong record of volunteerism.

## Discussion:

A public call for nominations throughout the County was released in December of 2017. The acceptance of nominations was extended thru February of 2018. Nominations were reviewed by the Parks and Recreation Commission in March of 2018.

Parks and Recreation Commission, after consideration of the nominations and criteria for the award, selected a nominee for the award on March 9, 2018
