***Project Title/Description:**

Donation of Equipment: Dual purpose Police K9

***Purpose:**

The purpose of this item is to request Board approval to accept the donation of equipment from the Arizona Law Enforcement Canine Association "ALECA" to the Pima County Sheriff's Department Canine Unit. The value of the equipment is \$20,000.00. ALECA has provided donations in the past to other departments in the state who have lost canines in the line of duty. ALECA along with donating partners understand the costs for a Dual Purpose Police K9 and are honored to assist Law Enforcement with incurred costs after tragic events occur.

***Program Goals/Predicted Outcomes:**

The Arizona Law Enforcement Canine Association (ALECA) purchase a Dual Purpose Police K9 for the Pima County Sheriff's Department Canine Unit to replace Canine Kenzo who died in the line of duty.

***Public Benefit:**

Economic Benefit: The ALECA donation will relieve the department and public of the cost and ensures K9 Kenzo is replaced within the Sheriff's Department Canine Unit.

Public and Law Enforcement Benefit: The importance of a well-trained, responsibly handled, and appropriately deployed Dual Purpose K9 not only provides the public with increased security but enhances public and officer safety with the canines ability to deter, detect, disrupt, and detain violent offenders in the community. There was an extraordinary amount of public sympathy for the loss of Kenzo. This donation provides recognition of public trust and ensures the Canine Unit will respectfully and honorably replace Kenzo.

***Metrics Available to Measure Performance:**

There are different performance measurements associated with a Dual Purpose Police K9. The first is selection, testing, and training. The handler will first test and evaluate the appropriate canine from a vendor that fits the mission profile. They will ensure correct temperament and drive. Performance measures are tested after an 8-12 week State Certified Training Course in which the handler and canine are expected to pass. This is documented and kept throughout the career of the canine. The second is tracking and measuring deployment performance measures. When the canine is deployed, case reports are done to document the incidents and use of force forms are completed for justification. Monthly and annual statistics are kept to measure performance reporting deployments, apprehensions, and de-escalation outcomes.
