## Dear Supervisors,

I urge each one of you to vote NO on agenda item #37.

Please reject any contract with SCI which might entangle Pima County with Smart Growth and 15-minute city plans which run contrary to the interests and well-being of County residents.

As I'm sure you are all aware, the SCI Economic Blueprint (in tandem with the <u>Pima County Economic Development Plan</u> and the Pima Prospers comprehensive plan) focuses on four expected growth sectors — aerospace and defense; bioscience and health care; alternative energy and natural resources; and transportation and logistics.

Given that SCI is one of the contributors to the <u>Pima Prospers</u> comprehensive plan, which is disturbingly similar in many respects to the City of Tucson's <u>Tucson Resilient Together</u> climate action plan, and that the <u>ICLEI</u>-subscribing <u>PAG</u> (Pima Association of Governments) is also involved, one would speculate that areas like health care, alternative energy and transportation may be tied in to United Nations- and World Economic Forum-touted urban planning models like SMART cities and 15-minute cities.

If so, many of these new jobs (nearly 40,000 of them) would be directly related to employing the residents of Pima County to build their own prison.
