ELECTIONS

3. 2024 General Election Recount

Pursuant to A.R.S. §16-661(A) and §16-664(A), the Elections Department recommends approval to petition for and conduct a recount for the office of County Sheriff.

Daniel Jurkowitz, Assistant Chief Civil Deputy County Attorney, stated that A.R.S. §16.661 required a recount where the margin between the two candidates who received the greatest number of votes was less than or equal to one half of 1% and that in the approved general election canvass the margin for the Office of Pima County Sheriff was 0.2%, which met the statutory requirement for an automatic recount. He stated that the Board was required to petition and certify those results to the Superior Court within 24 hours and prepare a pleading which would be done upon the Board's approval.

It was moved by Chair Grijalva, seconded by Supervisor Scott and carried by a 4-0 vote, Supervisor Heinz was absent, to approve the item.
