

FOURTH AMENDMENT TO OPERATING AGREEMENT

1. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE; EFFECTIVE DATE

- 1.1. Pima County, a political subdivision of the State of Arizona ("County") owns real property at 1090 E. River Rd., Tucson, Arizona (the "Property"), which is depicted in Exhibit A.
- 1.2. Rillito Park Foundation, an Arizona non-profit corporation ("Operator") currently occupies the Property under an Operating Agreement # CTN-RPS-23*0185 (formally known as CTN-PW-21-0094, reissued due to internal department/unit revisions), dated July 1, 2021, and First Amendment dated July 1, 2023. The First Amendment to Operating Agreement terminated on June 30, 2024, Second and Third Amendment are scheduled to terminate on June 30, 2025.
- 1.3 The parties wish to extend the Term of the Operating Agreement for an additional one-year term.

- 1.4 Effective Date: This Amendment is effective as of July 1, 2025.
- 2. **MODIFICATION OF OPERATING AGREEMENT.** County and Operator hereby modify the terms of the Agreement as follows. Sections 2.2 through 2.8 below shall be inserted after Section 28 of the Agreement and numbered as 29-34 and other numbering adjusted accordingly:
- 2.1. **Term**: The Operating Agreement is extended for an additional one-year term, with the amended Term to begin on July 1, 2025, and terminate on June 30, 2026, unless otherwise terminated or extended by the parties.
- 2.2. **Hazardous Material**. Replace reference in Section 10.1 to NRS 459.400 *et seq.* with ARS § 49-921 et seq.
- 2.3. Non-Appropriation of Funds. The parties recognize that the performance by the County may be dependent upon the appropriation of funds by the Board of Supervisors of the County, or the availability of funding from other sources. Should the governing body fail to appropriate the necessary funds, if County's appropriation is reduced during the fiscal year, or if funding becomes otherwise not legally available to the County hereunder, the County may reduce the scope of this Agreement if appropriate or terminate the Agreement without further duty or obligation to Operator. The County agrees to notify Operator as soon as reasonably possible after the unavailability of said funds comes to its attention.
- 2.4. **Authority to Contract.** Operator warrants its right and power to enter into this Agreement. If any court or administrative agency determines that County does not have authority to enter into this Agreement, County will not be liable to Operator or any third party by reason of such determination or by reason of this Lease.
- 2.5. **Israel Boycott Certification.** Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-393.01, if Operator engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees, and if this Agreement has a value of \$100,000.00 or more, Operator certifies it is not currently engaged in and agrees for the duration of this Agreement to not engage in, a boycott of goods or services from Israel. This certification does not apply to a boycott prohibited by 50 U.S.C. § 4842 or a regulation issued pursuant to 50 U.S.C. § 4842.
- 2.6. Forced Labor of Ethnic Uyghurs. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-394, if Operator engages in for-profit activity and has 10 or more employees. Tenant certifies it is not currently using, and agrees for the duration of this Agreement to not use (1) the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; (2) any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China; and (3) any contractors, subcontractors or suppliers that use the forced labor or any goods or services produced by the forced labor of ethnic Uyghurs in the People's Republic of China. If Operator becomes aware during the term of the Agreement that Operator is not in compliance with A.R.S. § 35-394. Operator must notify the County within 5 business days and provide a written certification to Owner regarding compliance within 180 days.

- 2.7. **Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan.** Pursuant to Pima County Procurement Code 11.40.030, Operator hereby warrants that if Operator's employees perform work in an outdoor environment under this Agreement Lease, Operator will keep on fil a written Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan. At County's request, Operator will provide a copy of this plan and documentation of heat safety and mitigation efforts implemented by Operator to prevent heat-related illnesses and injuries in the workplace. Operator will post a copy of the Heat Injury and Illness Prevention and Safety Plan where it is accessible to employees. Operator will further ensure that each subcontractor who performs any work for Operator under this Agreement complies with this provision.
- 2.8. **Severability.** Each provision of this Agreement stands alone, and any provision of this Agreement found to be prohibited by law will be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition without invalidating the remainder of this Agreement.
- 2.9. **Applicable Law**: Any legal action relating to this Lease must be brought in Arizona court in Pima County; Arizona law will apply to such disputes.
- 2.10. **Notices**: Any notice required hereunder must be delivered by electronic mail, personally or by certified mail, directed as follows:
